# 4. REVIEW OF POLITICAL PROPORTIONALITY AND APPOINTMENTS TO SCRUTINY AND OTHER COMMITTEES

**4.1** The following motion proposed by **R I N Gordon** and duly seconded, was CARRIED with no vote against:

That Council agrees that the Overview and Scrutiny Committee and Health Scrutiny Committee sizes as follows, subject to notes (1), (2), and (3) below:-

#### Notes:

- (1) In respect of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee, when considering education matters its Members will include six Parent Governor and Church representatives, as a result of which (but only at such times) the Conservative Group is entitled to an additional five Members. However, the Council waives the requirements for proportionality (so that the Conservative Group foregoes the five additional Members to which it is entitled when the Committee is considering education matters).
- (2) In respect of the Health Scrutiny Committee, the Committee will include one of its Members nominated by each Hertfordshire Borough and District Council as a result of which the Conservative Group is entitled to an additional nine Members. However, the Council waives the requirement for proportionality (so that the Conservative Group forgoes the nine additional Members to which it is entitled).
- (3) Provided that the Leader of any of the three largest political groups on the Council may, at any time, request a review of political proportionality in respect of Overview and Scrutiny and / or Health Scrutiny Committee.
