We have less money to spend.


This means we need to save more money and spend our money in the best way.

Other buses will stay the same.


There is a list of buses that would change. It starts on page 17.



Monday to Saturday

1. We want the buses to stop at about 7.30pm.

We said 6.30pm before but we changed it because it was a problem for some people.





Sunday

2. Most of the buses would not run on Sundays.

But the buses that go to hospitals would still run on Sundays.

These buses would stop at about 7.30pm.

Buses on bank holiday days would stop at about 7.30pm.

3. There are some things we look at to decide what buses to pay money for.

For example, we look at:

- what it costs for each bus journey
- what buses people need.

But we need a better way to look at this.



We want to look at more things to help us decide what buses to pay for.

These things are on the next page.

We would think about all these things.

But we think the things near the top are more important than the ones near the bottom.







The list of things we want to think about:

- 2. How much it costs us for each person to use the bus
- 3. How many people use the bus
- 4. How many older or disabled people use the bus
- 5. What other transport there is
- 6. How much we pay the people who run the buses



- 7. What might change in the future
- 8. How many young people use the bus. We have to pay for some young people to get to school or college.
