





Healthy Life Expectancy at Birth (No. of Years)







Rate of Injuries due to falls (65+) (per 100,000)













Number of Safe & Well Initiative Visits







Percentage of decisions for major county matter planning application









Street lighting defects rectified within the prescribed response times










% Schools rated Good or Outstanding






